STANDARD CONDITIONS OF FORMAL PROBATION

- √ Report to your Probation Officer within two working days upon completion of jail sentence and furnish him/her with requested information regarding yourself, including place of residence, exact post office address and contemplated or actual place of employment.
- √ Keep your Probation Officer informed of your whereabouts at all times and immediately notify him/her of any change of employment.
- √ Report to your Probation Officer monthly in writing, on forms provided, or in person as directed.
- √ While under probation, remain in custody of Probation Officer and whenever notified to do so, report in person to him/her or to this Court at the time & place designated in this notice. A written notice mailed at least 5 days prior to your appearance date, sent to you at the last post office address furnished by you is sufficient.
- √ Obey all laws.
- √ Diligently seek employment, accept first honorable employment offered you and, as much as possible, remain employed during term of probation.

1203.4 PC PROBATIONER MAY WITHDRAW PLEA OF GUILTY OR OF NOLO CONTENDERE - WHEN

(a) In any case in which defendant has fulfilled the conditions of probation for the entire period of probation, or has been discharged prior to the termination of the period of probation, or in any other case in which a court, in its discretion and the interest of justice, determines that a defendant should be granted the relief available under this section, the defendant shall, at any time after the termination of the period of probation, if he is not then serving a sentence for any offense, on probation for any offense, or charged with the commission of any offense, be permitted by the court to withdraw his plea of guilty or plea of nolo contendere and enter a plea of not guilty; or, if he has been convicted after a plea of not guilty, the court shall set aside the verdict of guilty; and, in either case, the court shall thereupon dismiss the accusations or information against the defendant and except as noted below, he shall thereafter be released from all penalties and disabilities resulting from the offense of which he has been convicted, except as provided in Section 13555 of the Vehicle Code. The probationer shall be informed, in his probation papers, of this right and privilege and his right, if any, to petition for a certificate of rehabilitation and pardon. The probationer may make such application and change of plea in person or by attorney, or by the probation officer authorized in writing; provided, that, in any subsequent prosecution of the defendant for any other offense, the prior conviction may be pleaded and proved and shall have the same effect as if probation had been granted or the accusation or information dismissed; and provided further that the order shall state, and the probationer shall be informed, that the order does not relieve him of the obligation to disclose the conviction in response to any direct question contained in any questionnaire or application for public office or for licensure by any state or local agency.

Dismissal of an accusation or information pursuant to this section does not permit a person to own, possess, or have in his custody or control any firearm capable of being concealed upon the person or prevent his conviction under Section 12021.

The subdivision shall apply to all applications for relief under this section which are filed on or after November 23, 1970.

(b) Subdivision (a) of this section does not apply to any misdemeanor which is within the provisions of subdivision (B9) of section 42001 of the Vehicle Code or to any infractions.

REFERRAL TO DRINKING DRIVER PROGRAMS (Wet Reckless, 1st Offense, or Multiple Offense DUI)

Reporting Instructions: Telephone 565-7640 (565-7642 Spanish Speaking line; se habla espanol) to schedule an intake appointment immediately following your court action to ensure enrollment compliance or a warrant may be issued. For your appointment, report to: **Sonoma County Drinking Driver Program, 1300 Coddington Center, Santa Rosa, CA 95401.** Office hours: 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. weekdays.

You will be required to comply with the following general program regulations:

1. To attend & participate in all education & counseling as scheduled.
2. To pay program fees as agreed. A non-refundable enrollment fee is required at intake; the balance will be paid as outlined by program.
3. Program sobriety **must** be maintained. A subsequent alcohol related arrest (DUI) while in the program will result in termination from the classes, referral back to Court, and your probation could be revoked or violated.

INTERLOCK IGNITION DEVICE

Contact the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) for directions on how to arrange installation. You are further ordered as follows:

1. You must install a certified Ignition Interlock Device (IID) on any vehicle that you own or operate & are prohibited from operating a motor vehicle unless the vehicle is equipped with a functioning, certified IID. The IID must be installed during the probationary period for the length of time directed.
2. Please be advised that installation of an IID on a vehicle does not allow you to drive without a valid driver's license.
3. You shall arrange for each vehicle with an IID to be serviced by the installer at least once every 60 days for the installer to recalibrate and monitor the operation of the device.

Reporting instructions: Within 48 hours of your appearance in Court, contact the Project Intercept office in person - **DO NOT CALL.** Failure to do so will result in the issuance of a warrant for your arrest.
